






Summary

59,434 people are registered with GP practices in GP practices in Affinity Care Community Partnership. 80% of the population reside in Wyke, Queensbury, Shipley, Thornton and Allerton, Windhill and Wrose, Clayton and Fairweather Green, , Idle and Thackley, Bingley Rural and Heaton. These wards are part of Bradford South, Bradford East, Bradford West and Shipley area committees. The population of this Community Partnership is generally older than the Bradford District and Craven CCG average. Life expectancy for both females and males is better than the CCG average. There are also low levels of premature mortality from all causes, CVD and respiratory disease. Child excess weight for reception and year 6 is similar to CCG average. Overall, the health and wellbeing of population of WISHH community partnership is better in some areas and similar in other areas to Bradford District and Craven.

Life Expectancy


Three Year Averages 2018-20




Teenage Pregnancy

Number of conceptions per 1,000 females aged 15-17 2017-19




Child Excess Weight
