



57,535 people are registered with GP practices in Bradford City & Horton Collaborative Community Partnership which forms part of the Central Locality 77% of the population resides in City, Little Horton, Manningham, Toller, and Heaton wards which are part of the Bradford West and Bradford East area committees.. The population of this Community Partnership is generally younger than the Bradford District and Craven CCG average. Life expectancy for females is better than the CCG average but worse for males. Child excess weight (reception) is better than the district average but worse for those in Year 6. There is a high rate of infant mortality compared to other areas of Bradford District and Craven and premature mortality from CVD is higher than average. However premature mortality rates for respiratory disease and cancer is similar to the CCG average. Overall, the health and wellbeing of Bradford City & Horton Collaborative is better than some areas of Bradford District and Craven but worse than others.




Teenage Pregnancy

Number of conceptions per 1,000 females aged 15-17 2017-19




Child Excess Weight
