






Summary

53,583 people are registered with GP practices in Central 5 Community Partnership which forms part of the Central Locality. 80% of the population resides in Bradford Moor, Bowling & Barkerend, Bolton & Undercliffe and City wards which are part of the Bradford East and Bradford West area committees. The population of this Community Partnership is younger than other areas of Bradford District and Craven. Life expectancy for females is similar to the CCG average but below average for males. The rate of child excess weight(reception) and premature rates of mortality from CVD and respiratory disease are above the CCG average but that of cancer is lower than average. Overall, the health and wellbeing of Central 5 Community Partnership is generally worse than the CCG average.


Life Expectancy




Teenage Pregnancy

Number of conceptions per 1,000 females aged 15-17 2017-19




Child Excess Weight
