




#### Summary

**23,136** people are registered with GP practices in Craven Community Partnership which forms part of the Airedale Wharfedale & Craven Locality. The population of Craven Community Partnership is spread across a large number of wards, with about a quarter of the population residing in the wards of Skipton West, Skipton South and Skipton North The population of this Community Partnership is older than other areas of Bradford District and Craven. Life expectancy for females is similar to the CCG average but below average for males. The rate of child excess weight(reception) and premature rates of mortality from CVD and respiratory disease are above the CCG average but that of cancer is lower than average. Overall, the health and wellbeing of Craven Community Partnership is generally better than the CCG average.




### **Teenage Pregnancy**

Number of conceptions per 1,000 females aged 15-17 2017-19




