




Summary

35,065 people are registered with GP practices in Five End Lane Community Partnership which forms part of the North Locality. 82% of the population of Five Lane Ends Network Community Partnership reside in Eccleshill, Bolton & Undercliffe, Idle & Thackley and Bowling and Barkerend wards which form part of the Bradford East area committee. The population of this Community Partnership is similar to the Bradford District and Craven CCG average. Life expectancy for both males and females is similar to CCG average. Premature rates of mortality from all causes, cancer and respiratory disease are also similar to the CCG average. However, child excess weight for reception and year 6, and infant mortality are higher than CCG average. Overall, the health and wellbeing of Five Lane Ends Network is worse than community partnership average.

Life Expectancy


Three Year Averages 2018-20




Teenage Pregnancy

Number of conceptions per 1,000 females aged 15-17 2017-19




Child Excess Weight
