




Summary

33,082 people are registered with GP practices in The Village Community Partnership which forms part of the South Locality. The population of this Community Partnership is younger than other areas of the Bradford District and Craven CCG average. 79% of the population reside in Wyke, Queensbury, Thornton & Allerton and Clayton & Fairweather Green wards which are part of the Bradford South and Bradford West area committees. Life expectancy for both males and females is similar to the CCG average. Premature rates of mortality from all causes and respiratory disease are also similar to the CCG average. There is a higher rate of premature cancer deaths but lower rate of premature CVD mortality than community partnership average. The proportion of children in reception classified as overweight and obese is higher than average. Overall, the health and wellbeing of The Village is better than some areas but worse than others.


Life Expectancy

Deaths in persons age 0-74 years






Teenage Pregnancy
