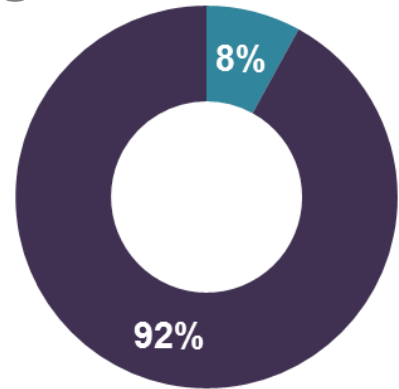

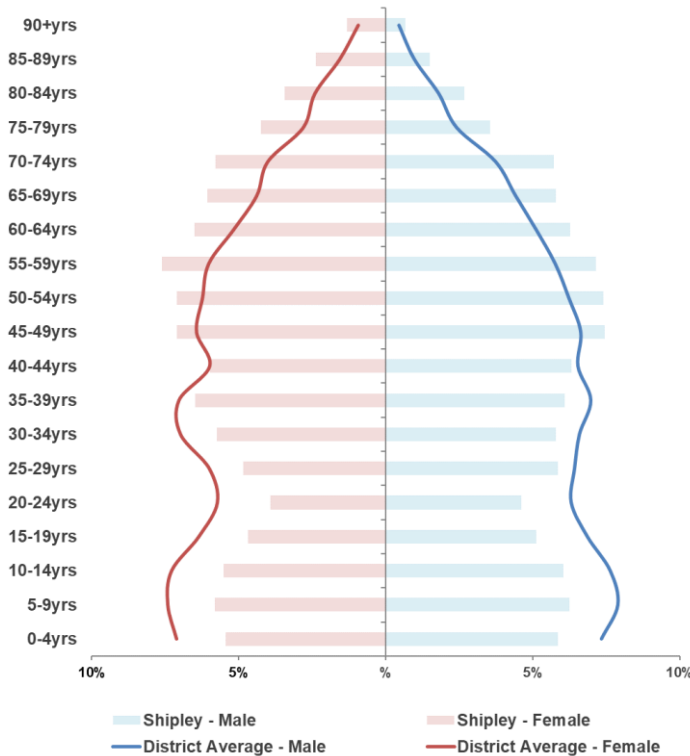

The population of Shipley has grown but less so than the average growth for the district. Shipley has the lowest proportion of non-white residents in the district.

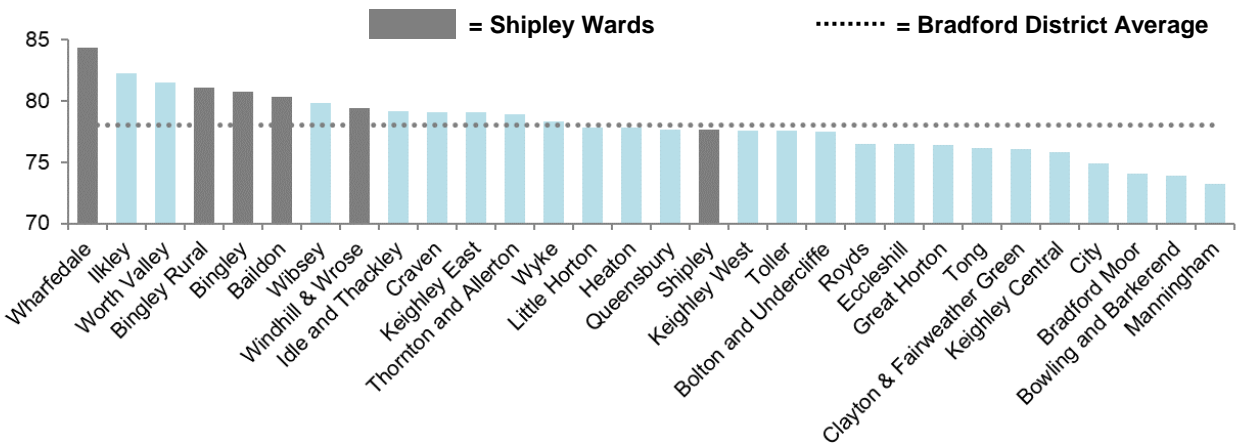

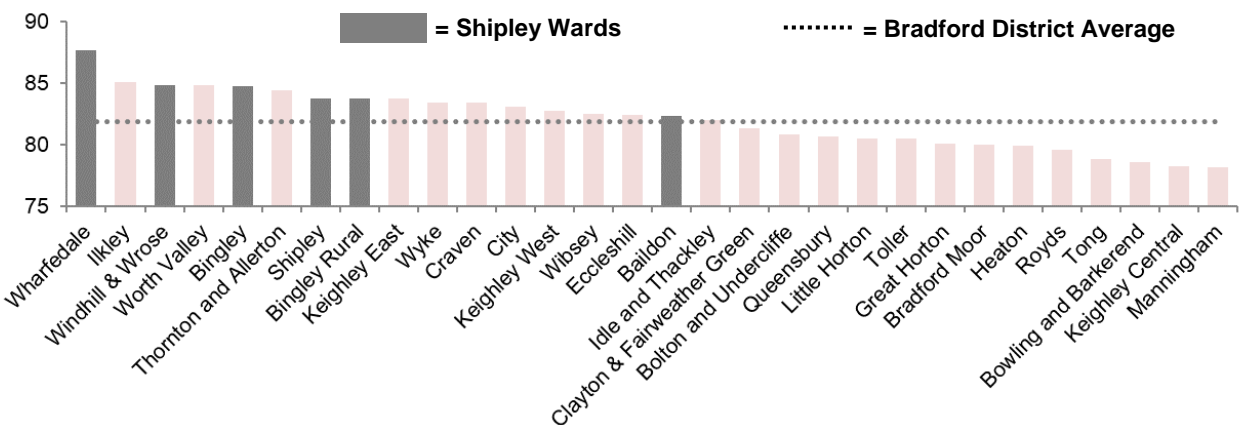

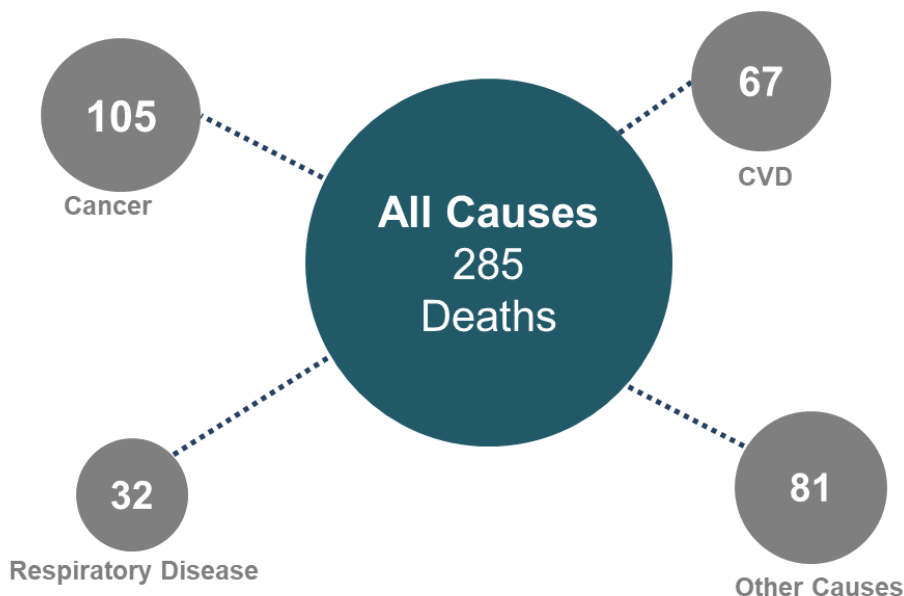
The 2017-19 life expectancy in Shipley is higher than the district average for both males and females. Male life expectancy in five of the six Shipley wards is higher than the district average. Furthermore, female life expectancy is higher than the district average in all wards in Shipley.

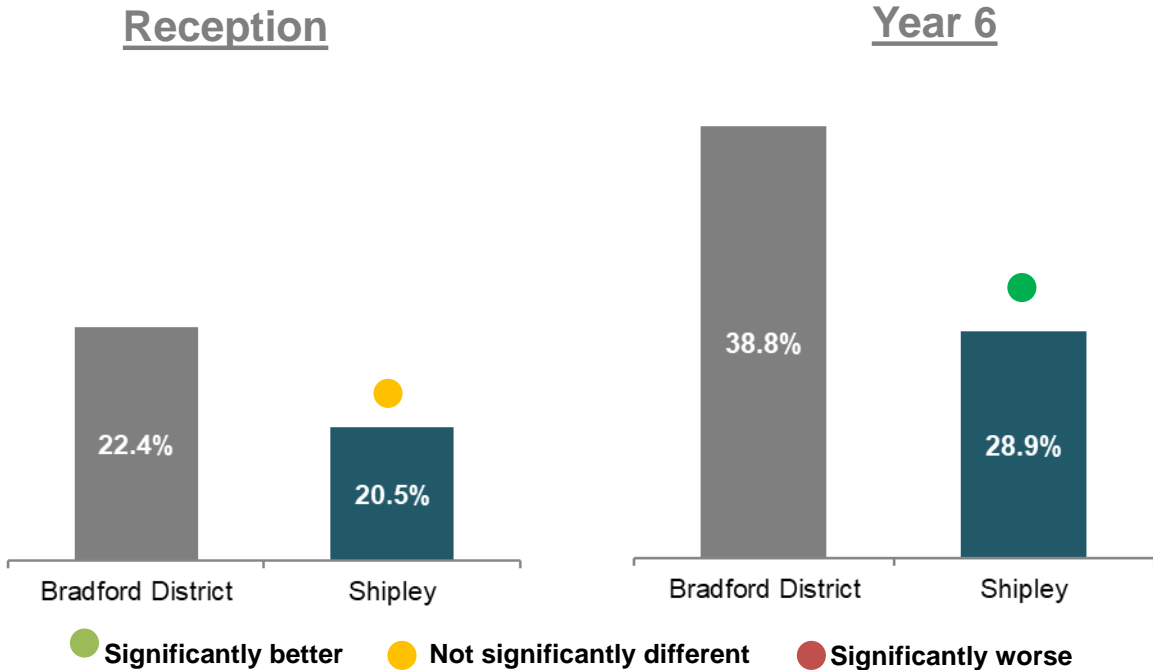

During 2017-19 there were an average of 285 premature mortalities per year in Shipley. 105 premature mortalities were caused by cancer; 67 were caused by CVD and 32 were caused by respiratory disease. The premature mortality rate due to cancer, CVD and respiratory disease in Shipley were all lower than the district average.

In Shipley 20.5% of children in reception are classed as overweight or obese, which is lower than the district average. The ward with the highest prevalence of excess weight in Shipley in reception is Bingley Rural. 28.9% of children in year 6 in Shipley are classed as overweight or obese which is also lower than the district average. The ward with the highest prevalence of year 6 excess weight in Shipley is Windhill & Wrose and the lowest prevalence is in Wharfedale.
