

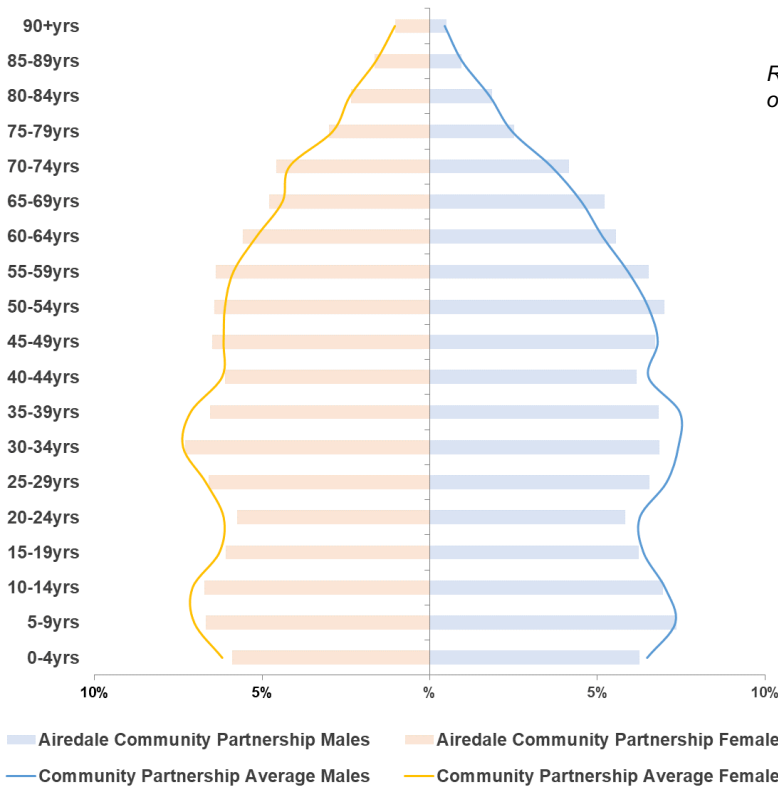
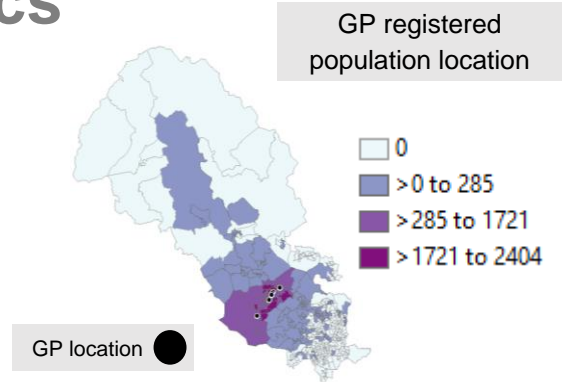

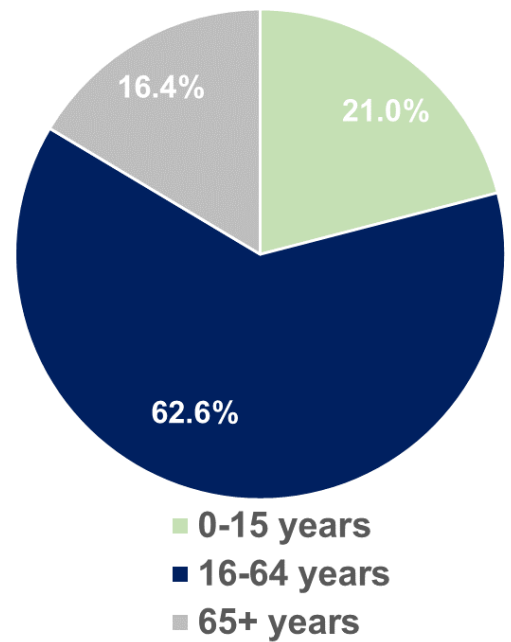

Population & Demographics

67,961 people are registered with GP practices in Airedale Community Partnership which forms part of the AWC Locality. 97.1% of the population resides in the Keighley Central, Keighley West, Keighley East, Worth Valley and Craven wards which are part of the Keighley area committee.



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Summary

The population of Airedale Community Partnership is younger than some parts of the district but older than others. In general the health and wellbeing of Airedale Community Partnership is similar to the Bradford District & Craven average. The percentage of adults that are smoke and who are obese is slightly higher than the average for Bradford District and Craven CCG. Premature mortality from respiratory disease, CVD and cancer is lower than the CCG average. The infant mortality rate is above the CCG average, however the teenage conception rate is below the CCG average.

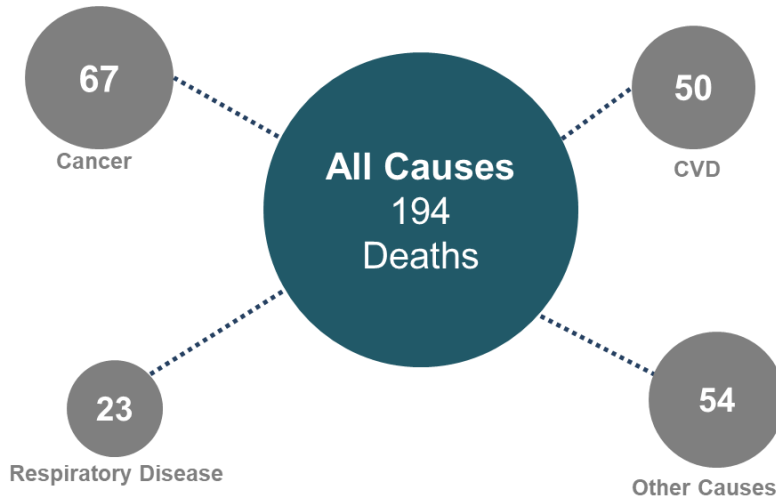

Death Rate: per 100,000 population

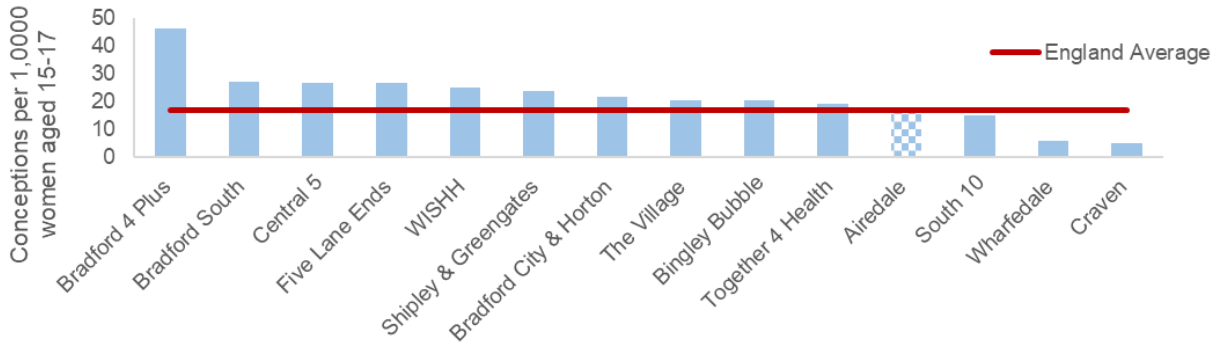

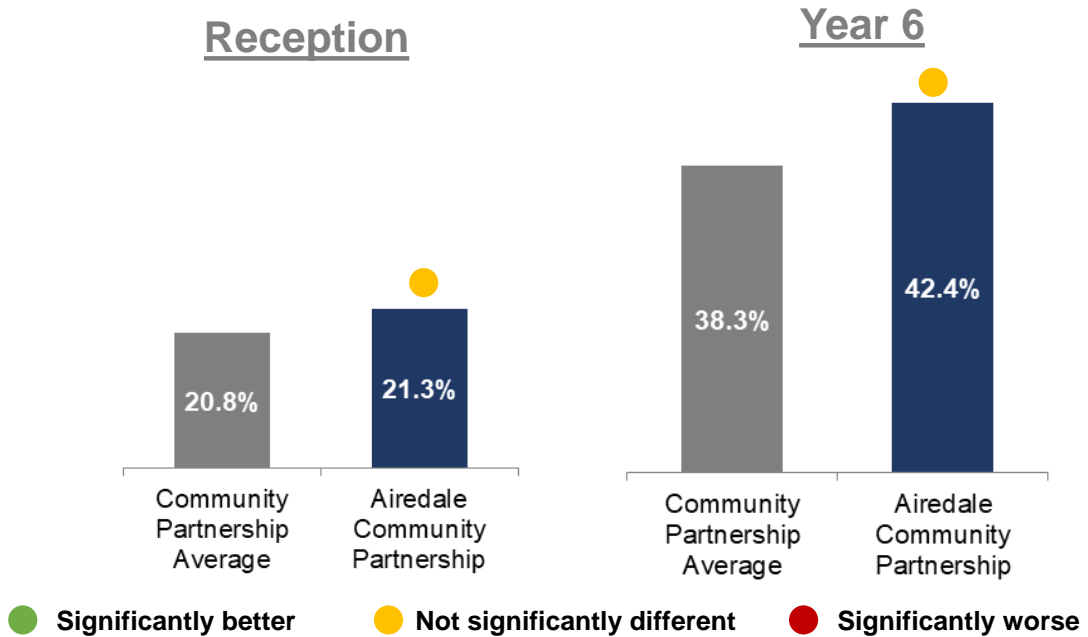
Teenage Pregnancy

2016-18



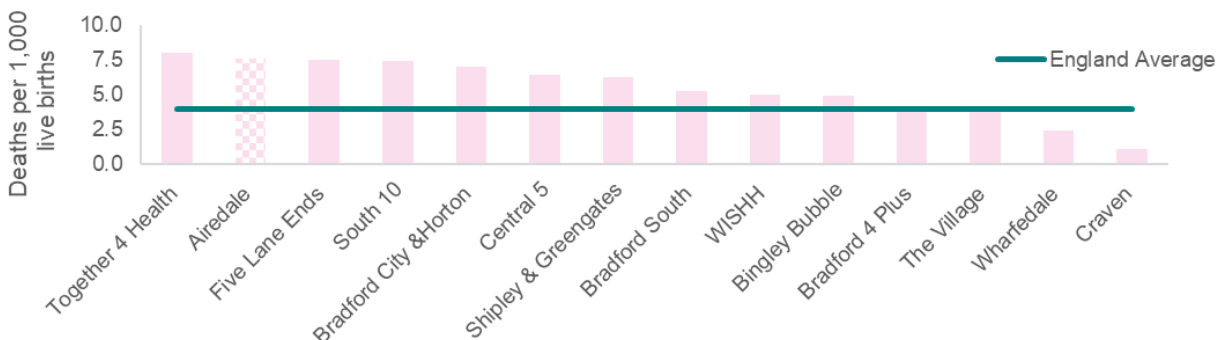
Child Excess Weight

2017/18 to 2019/20



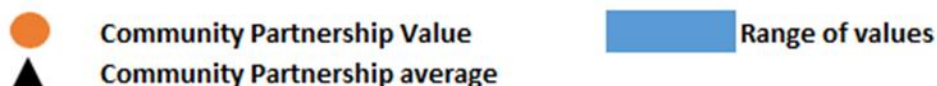
Infant Mortality
