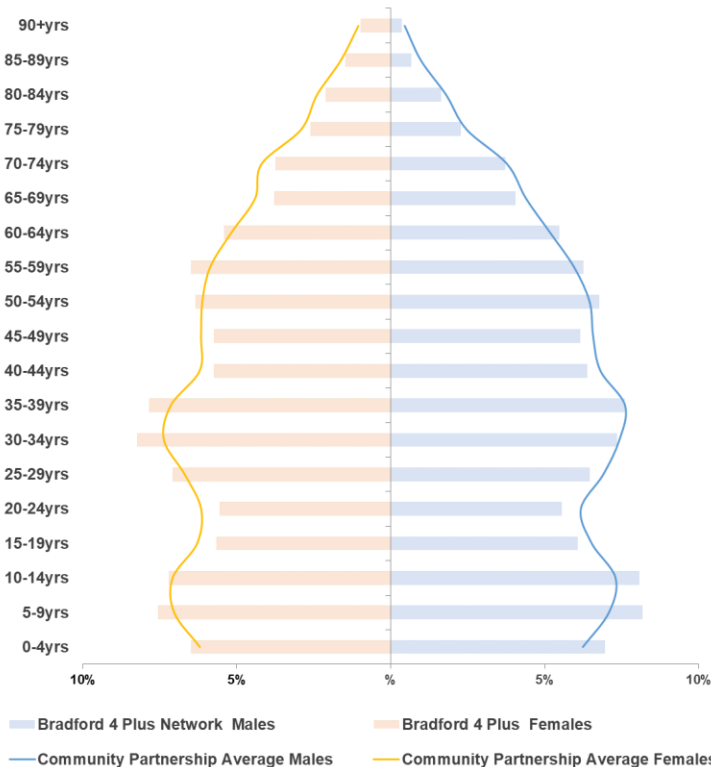
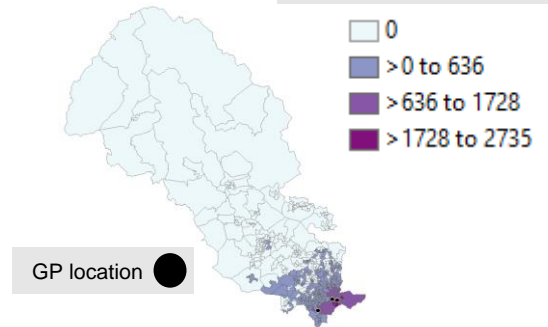

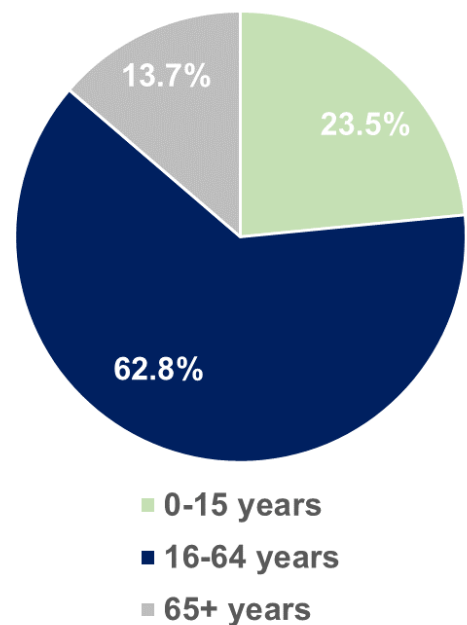
Population & Demographics

41,869 people are registered with GP practices in Bradford 4 Plus Network Community Partnership which forms part of the South Locality. 90% of the population resides in Tong, Bowling & Barkerend, Wyke, Wisbey and Royds wards which are part of the Bradford South and Bradford East area committees.

Summary

The population of Bradford 4 Plus Network Community Partnership is generally younger than the Bradford District and Craven CCG average. The health and wellbeing of Bradford 4 Plus Network is generally poor compared to other areas of Bradford District and Craven CCG. Male and female life expectancy is lower than the community partnership average and the rates of premature mortality due to respiratory disease, CVD and cancer are also above the community partnership average. However the rate of infant mortality and percentage of children in year 6 that are overweight or obese are below the community partnership average.

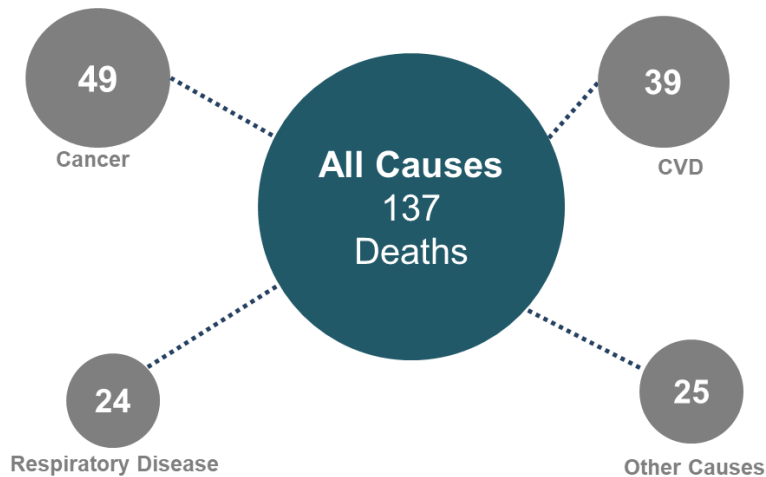

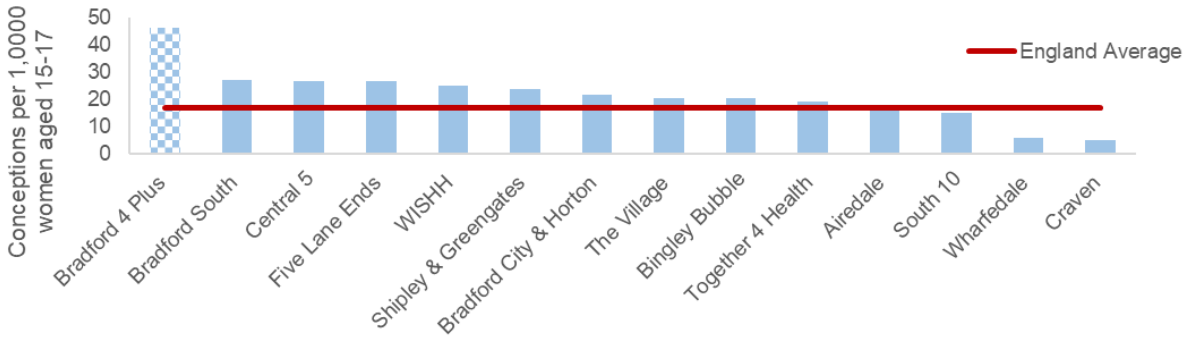

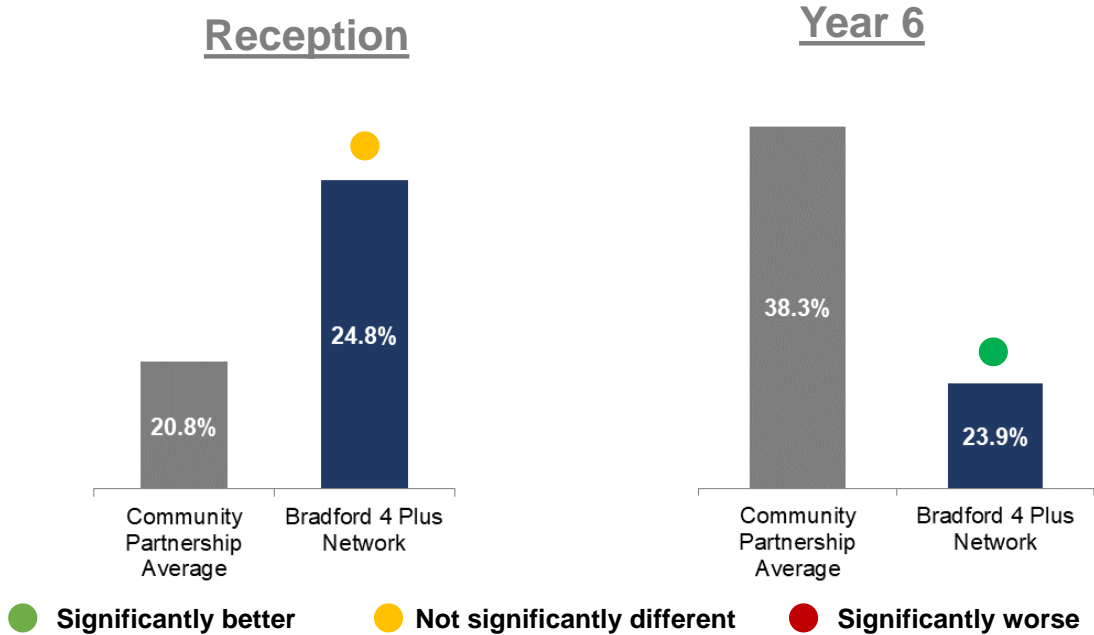
Teenage Pregnancy

2016-18



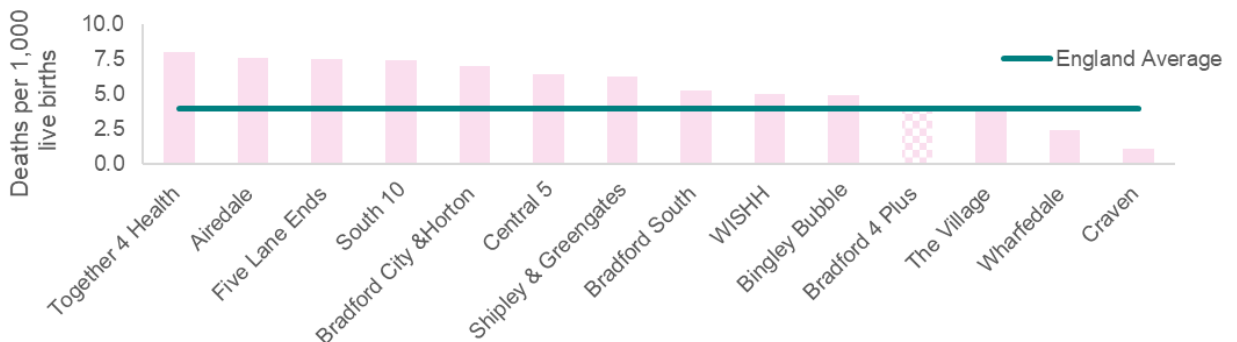
Child Excess Weight

2017/18 to 2019/20



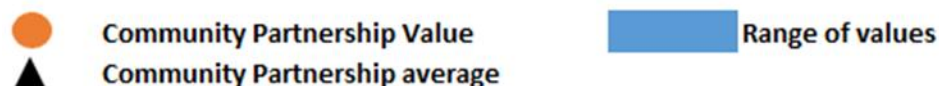
Infant Mortality
