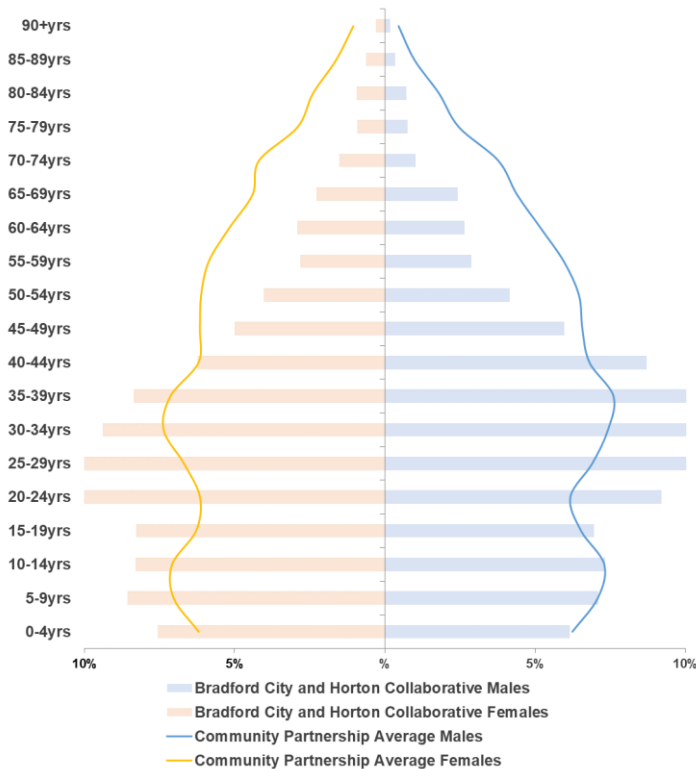
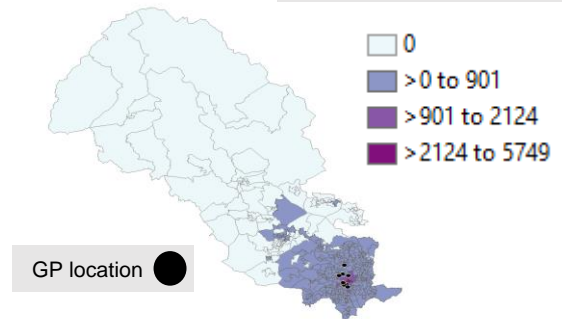

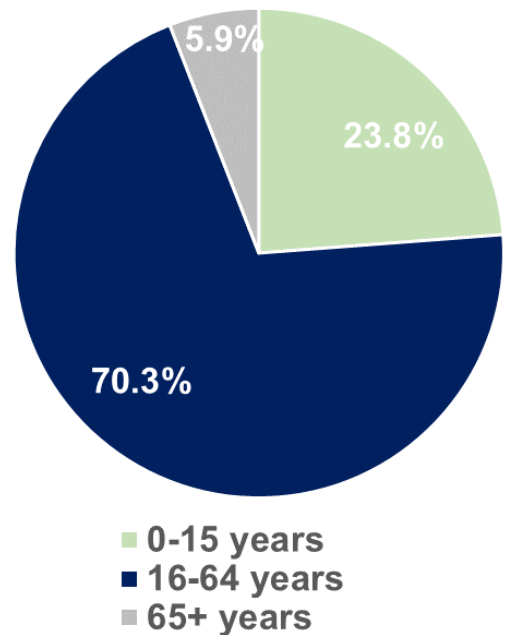
Population & Demographics

57,749 people are registered with GP practices in Bradford City & Horton Collaborative Community Partnership which forms part of the Central Locality. 77% of the population resides in City, Little Horton, Manningham, Toller, and Heaton wards which are part of the Bradford West and Bradford East area committees.

population location



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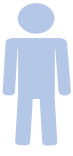


Summary

The population of Bradford City & Horton Collaborative Community Partnership is generally younger than the Bradford District and Craven CCG average. The health and wellbeing of Bradford City & Horton Collaborative is better than some areas of Bradford District and Craven but worse than others. Both male and female life expectancy is similar to the community partnership averages. However there are a high proportion of older people living in poverty as well as a large proportion of households that are classed as fuel poor. Child excess weight levels are similar to the district average but there a high rates of infant mortality compared to other areas of Bradford District and Craven.

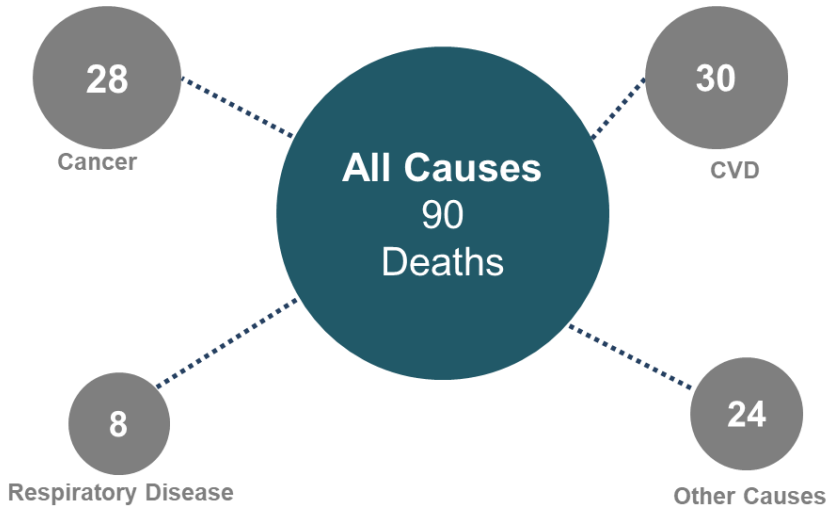

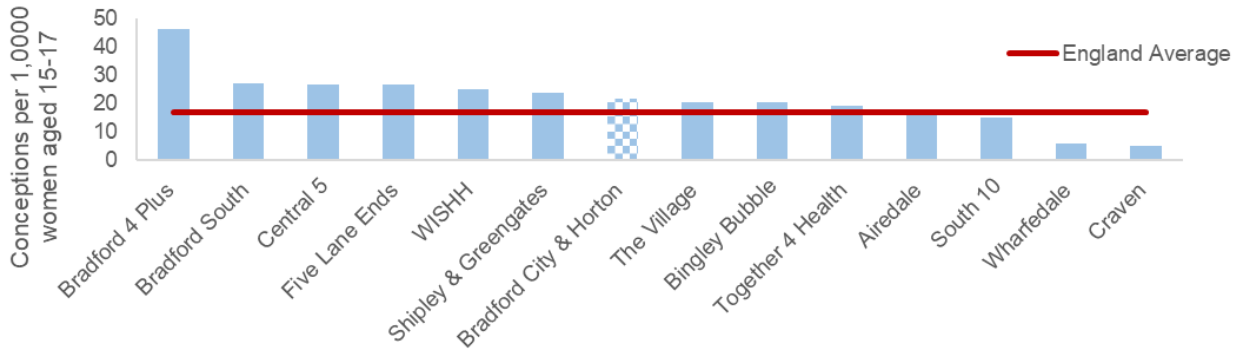

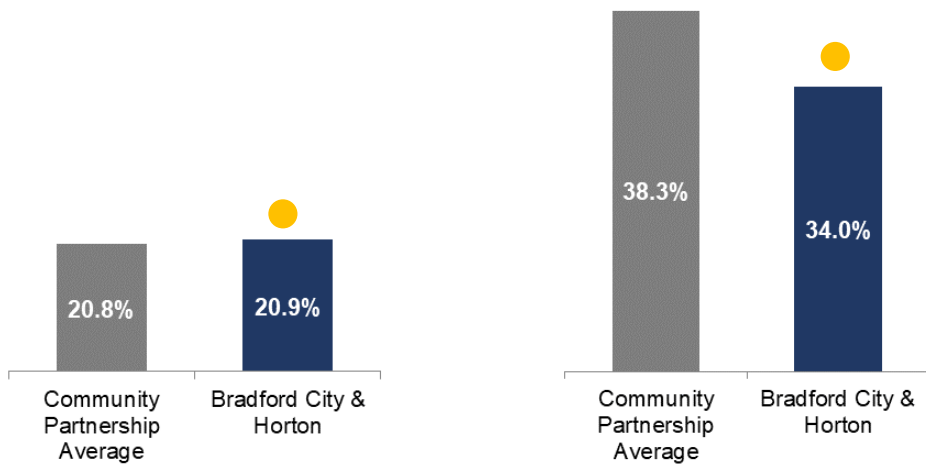


Child Excess Weight

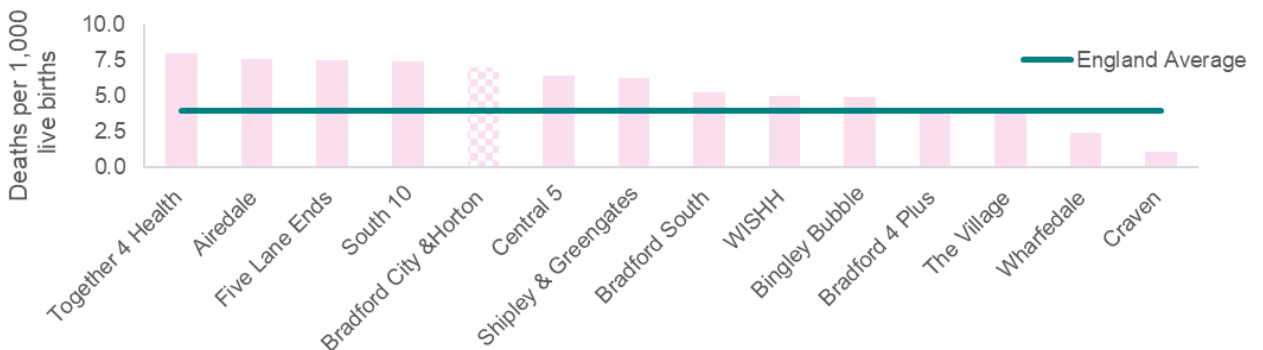

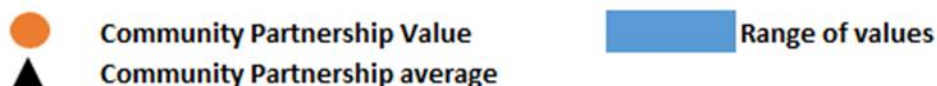
Infant Mortality
