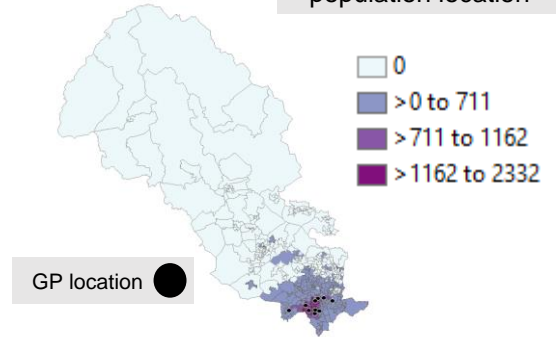

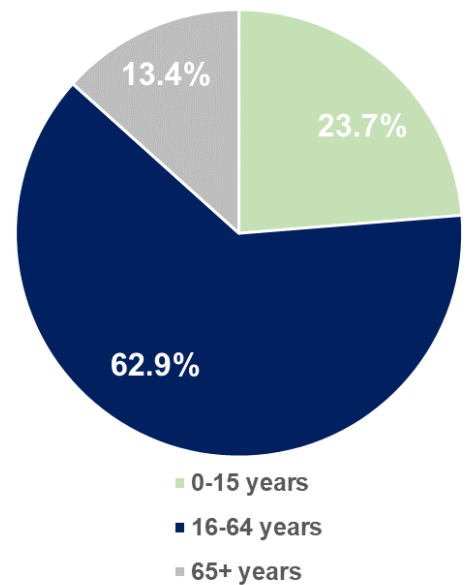
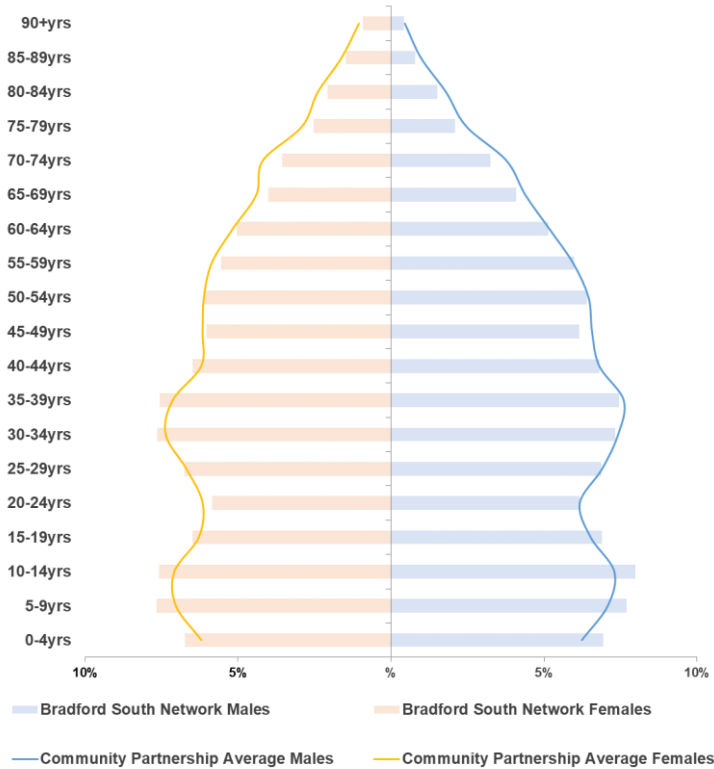
Population & Demographics

63,233 people are registered with GP practices in Bradford South Network Community Partnership which forms part of the South Locality. 82% of the population resides in Royds, Great Horton, Wibsey, City and Queensbury wards which are part of the Bradford South and Bradford West area committees.

GP registered population location



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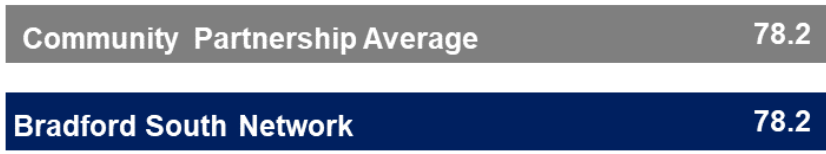


Summary

The population of Bradford South Network Community Partnership is older than some parts of Bradford District and Craven CCG but younger than others. The health and wellbeing of Bradford South Network is similar to the community partnership average. Male life expectancy is similar to the average whilst female life expectancy is below the district average. A higher percentage of adults in Bradford South Network are unemployed than the Bradford District & Craven CCG average and more households are fuel poor. Infant mortality rates are below the CCG average but there are higher levels of excess weight in children in reception and year 6.

Life Expectancy

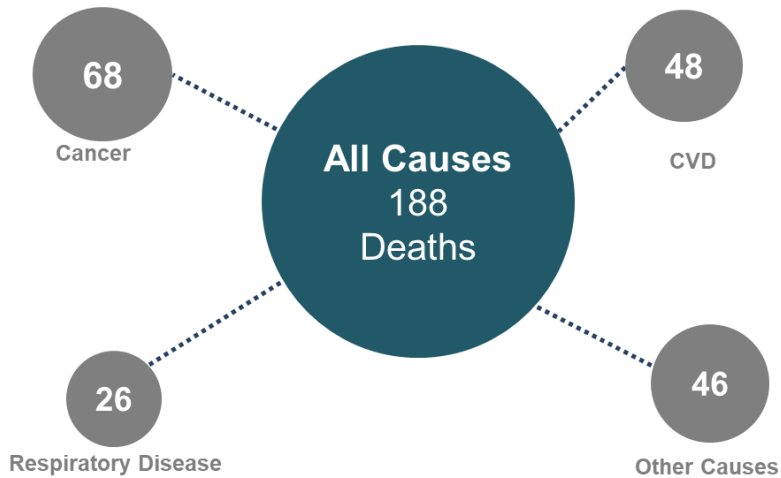

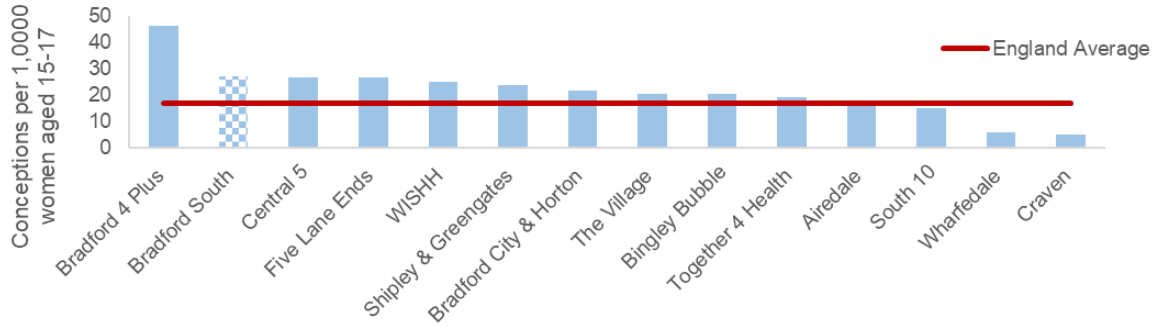

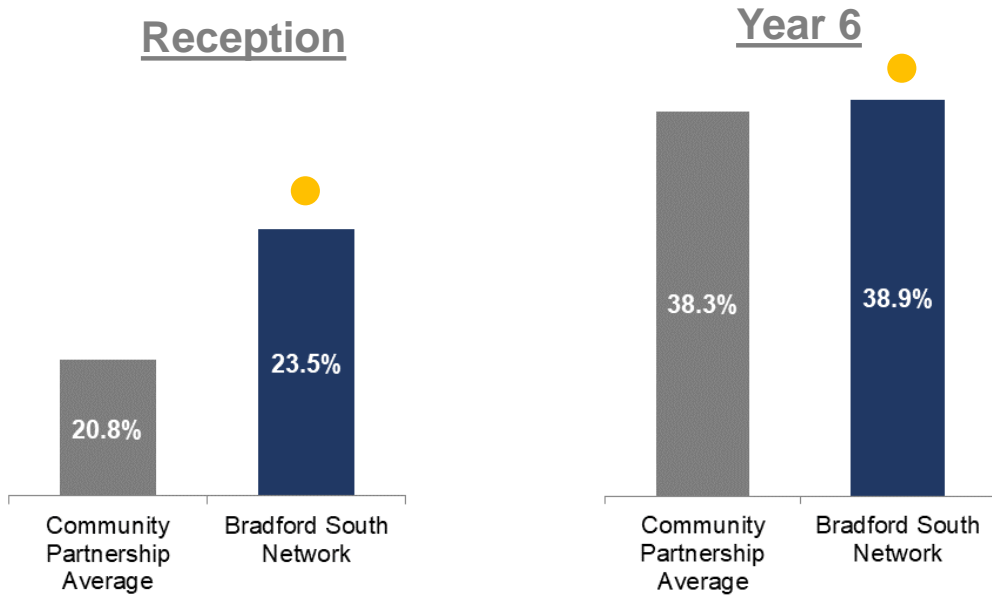
Teenage Pregnancy

Child Excess Weight

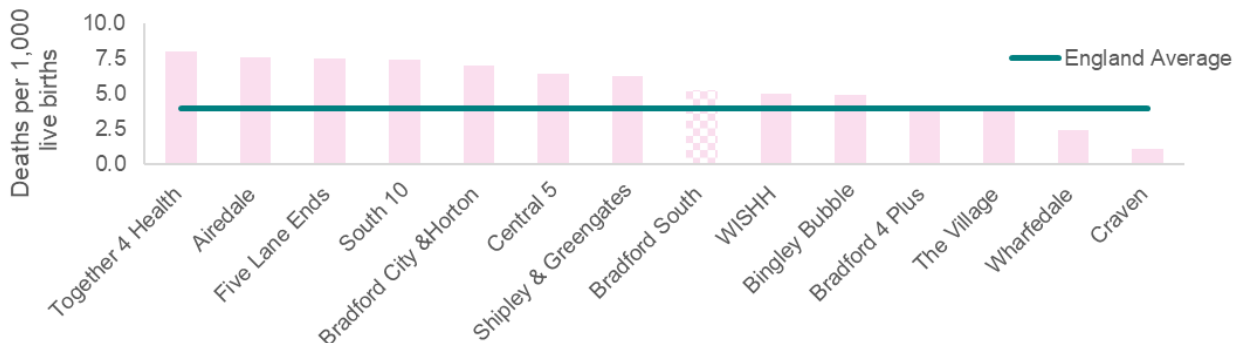
Proportion of children classified as overweight or obese

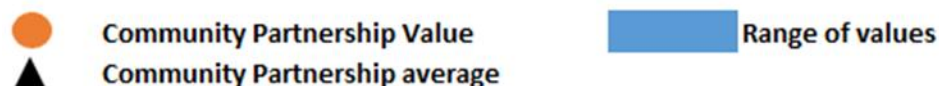
Infant Mortality
