

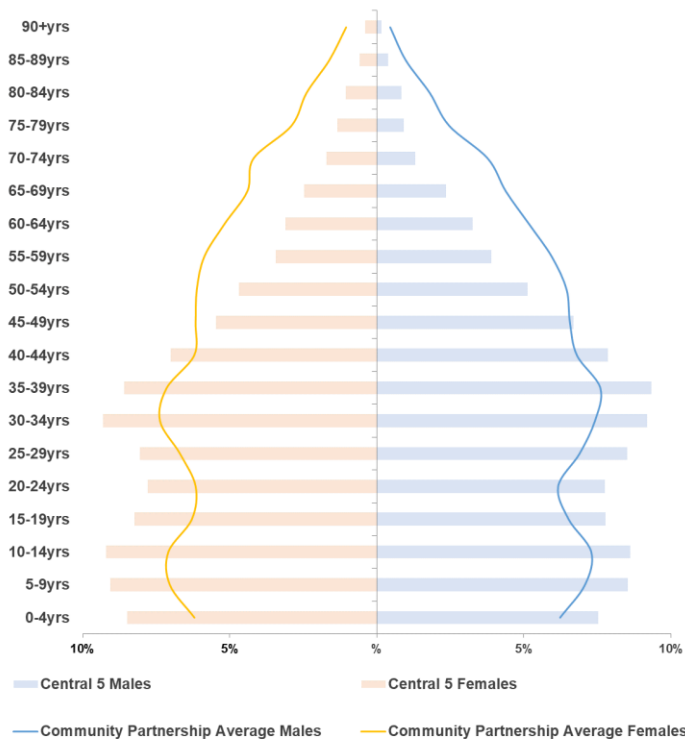
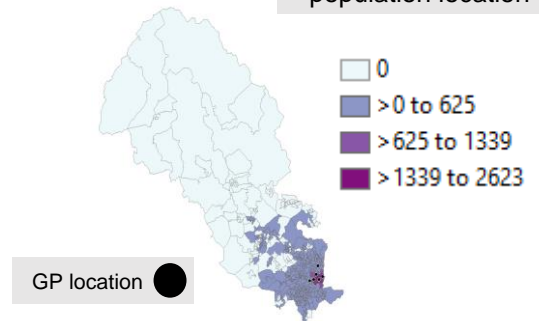

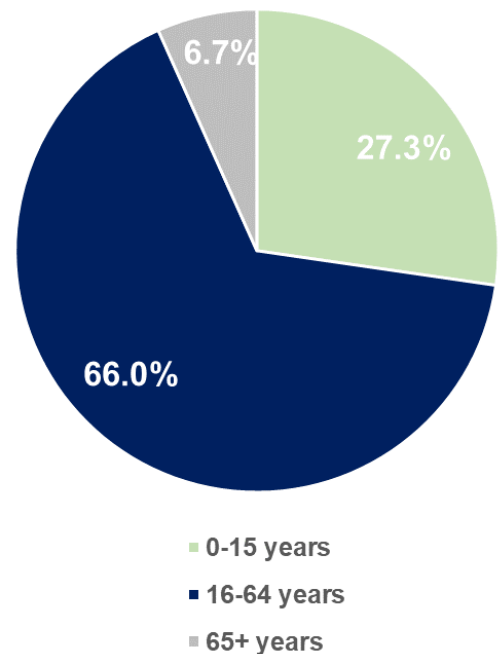
Population & Demographics

52,149 people are registered with GP practices in Bradford South Network Community Partnership which forms part of the Central Locality. 80% of the population resides in Bradford Moor, Bowling & Barkerend, Bolton & Undercliffe and City wards which are part of the Bradford East and Bradford West area committees.

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Summary

The population of Central 5 Community Partnership is younger than other areas of Bradford District and Craven CCG. The health and wellbeing of Central 5 Community Partnership is generally worse than the CCG average. Both female and male life expectancy is below the CCG average and premature rates of mortality from CVD, respiratory disease and cancer are above the CCG average. There are high levels of child excess weight for reception and year 6 and a high proportion of households are fuel poor. However there are lower levels of dementia and depression in adults recorded than the CCG average.

Life Expectancy

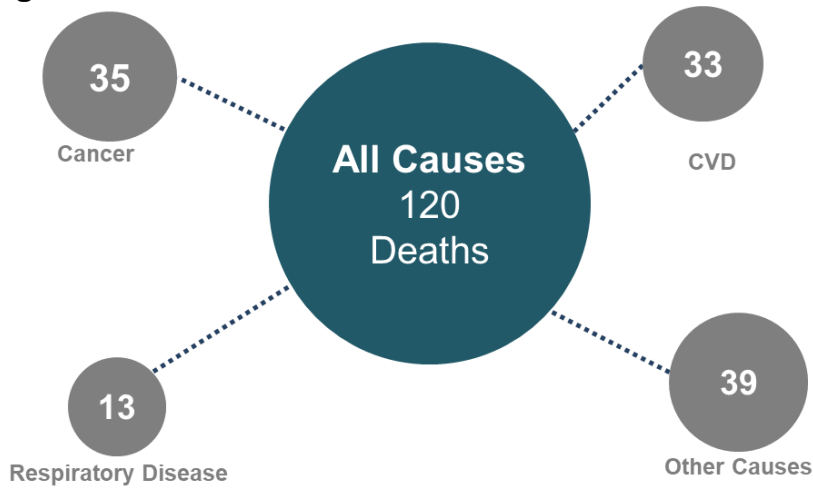
Three Year Averages

Death Rate: per 100,000 population

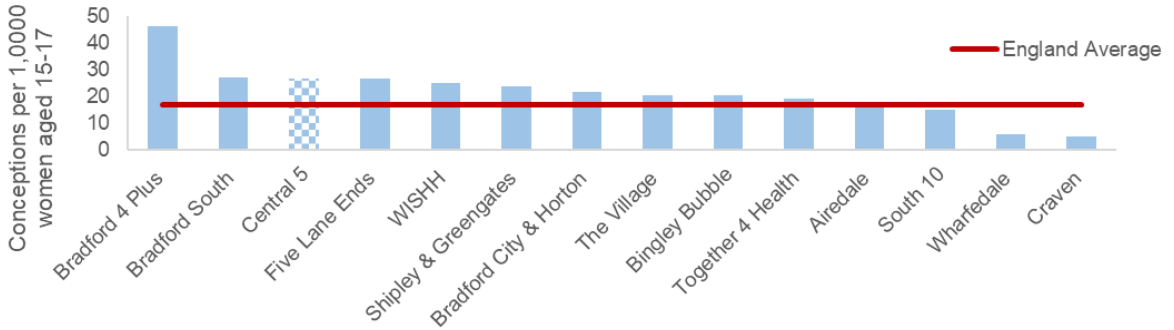

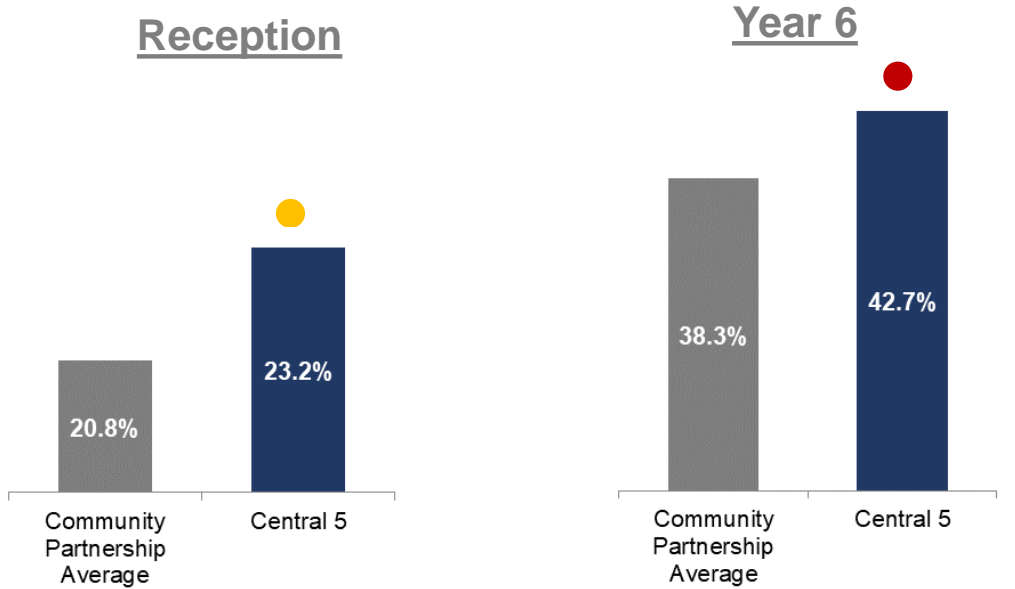
Teenage Pregnancy

Child Excess Weight

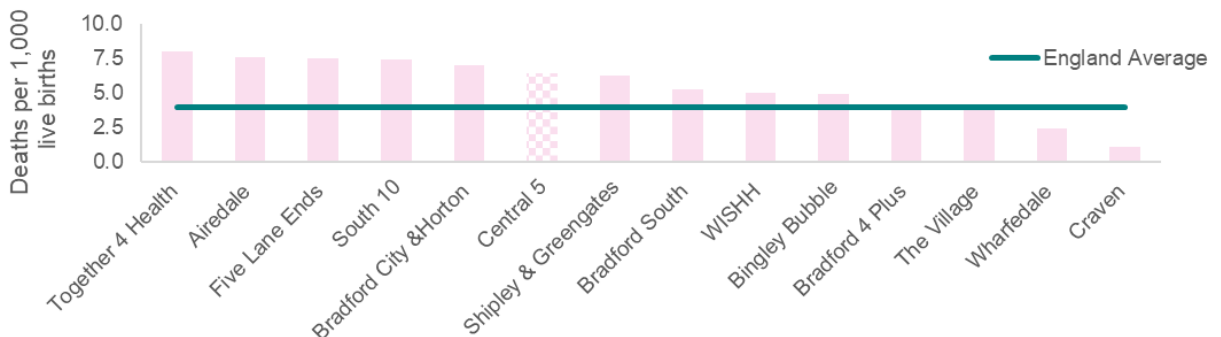
Proportion of children classified as overweight or obese

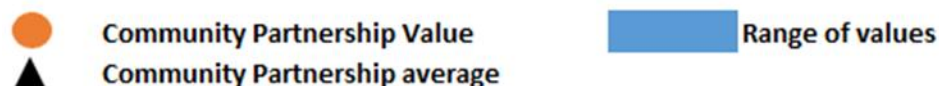
Infant Mortality
