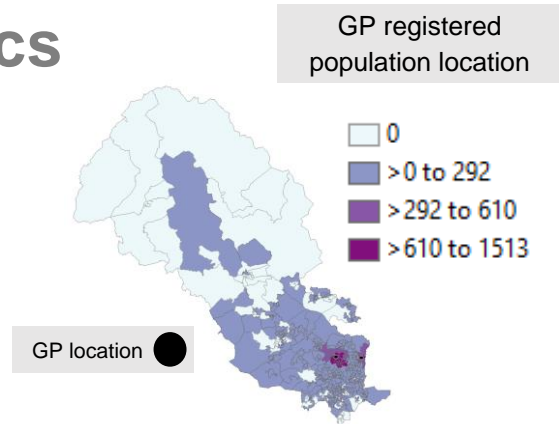


ShIPLEY and Greengates Loop Community Partnership

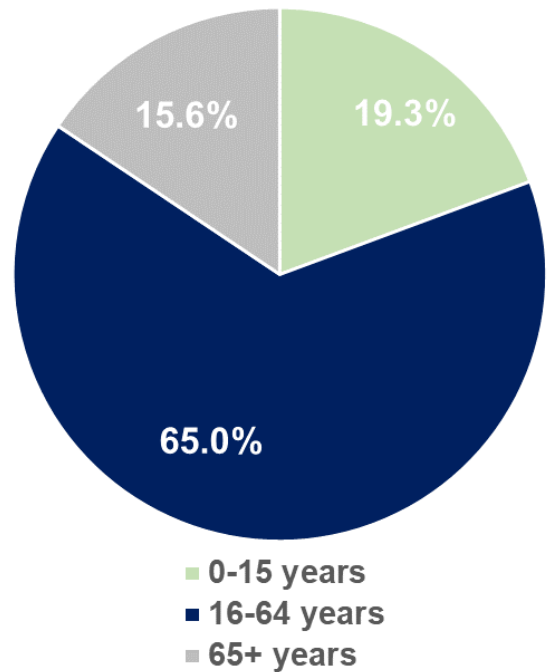
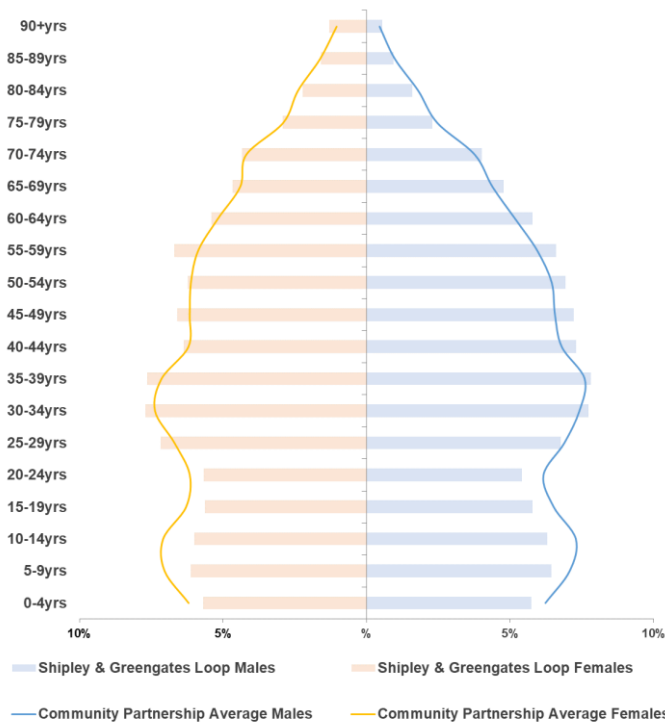

Population & Demographics

25,594 people are registered with GP practices in ShIPLEY and Greengates Loop Community Partnership which forms part of the North Locality. 69% of the population of Five Lane Ends Network Community Partnership reside in ShIPLEY, Windhill & Wrose, Idle & Thackley and Heaton wards which form part of the ShIPLEY, Bradford East and Bradford West area committees.



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Summary

The population of ShIPLEY and Greengates Loop is older than other parts of Bradford District and Craven. The health and wellbeing of the population of ShIPLEY and Greengates Loop is better than some areas but worse than others. Male and female life expectancy is below the Bradford District and Craven average and there are high rates of premature mortality from respiratory disease, cancer and CVD. Fewer than average houses are fuel poor and fewer older adults are living in poverty. There are above average levels of children with excess weight in year 6 but low levels of teenage pregnancy.

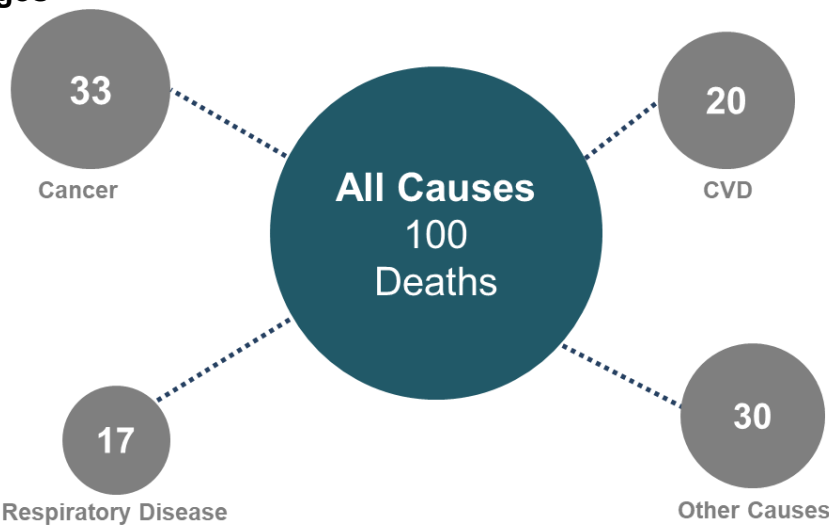

Death Rate: per 100,000 population

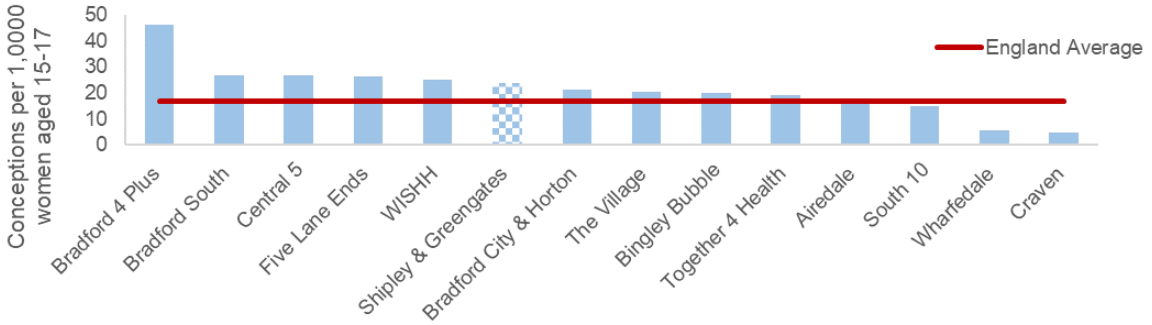

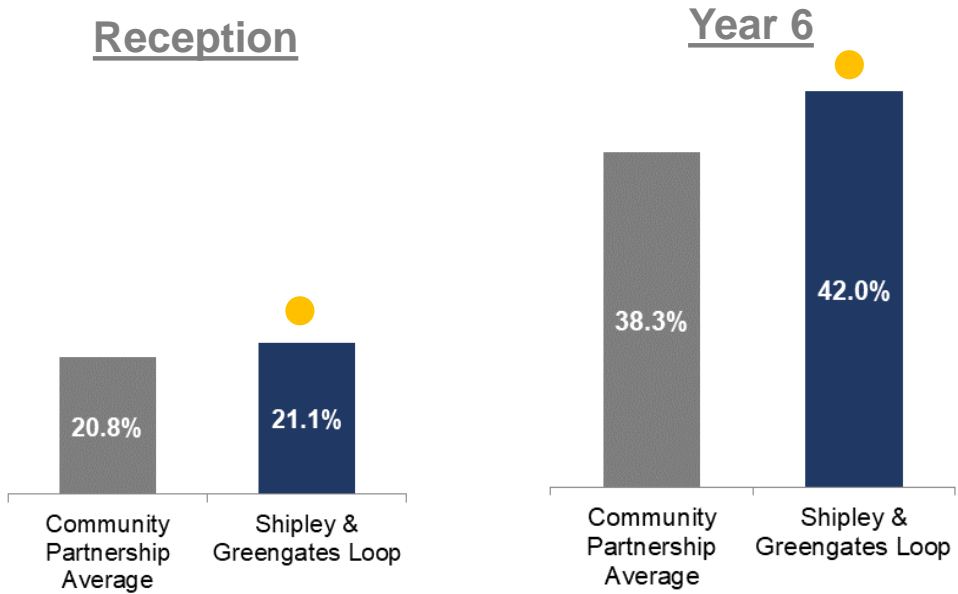
Teenage Pregnancy

Child Excess Weight

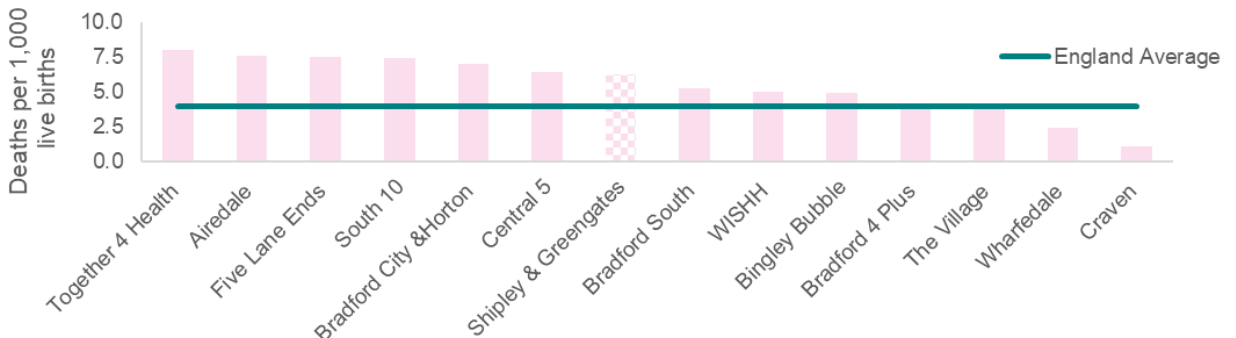
Proportion of children classified as overweight or obese

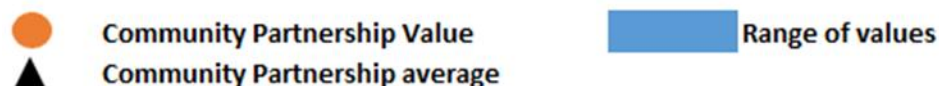
Infant Mortality
