

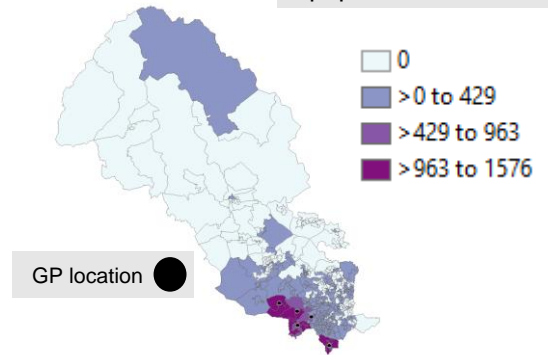

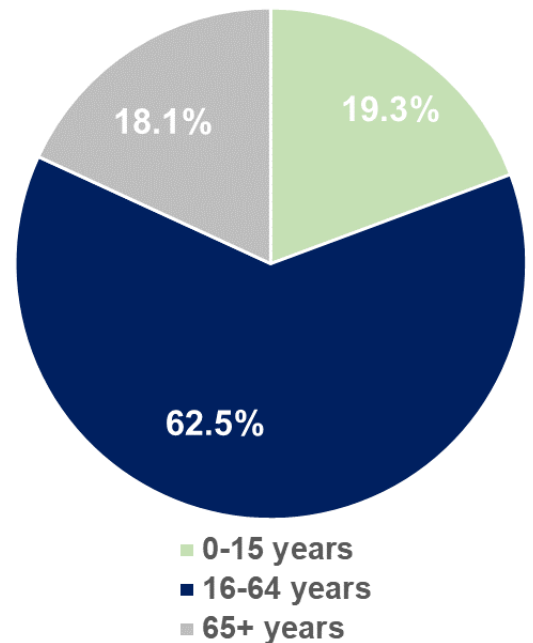
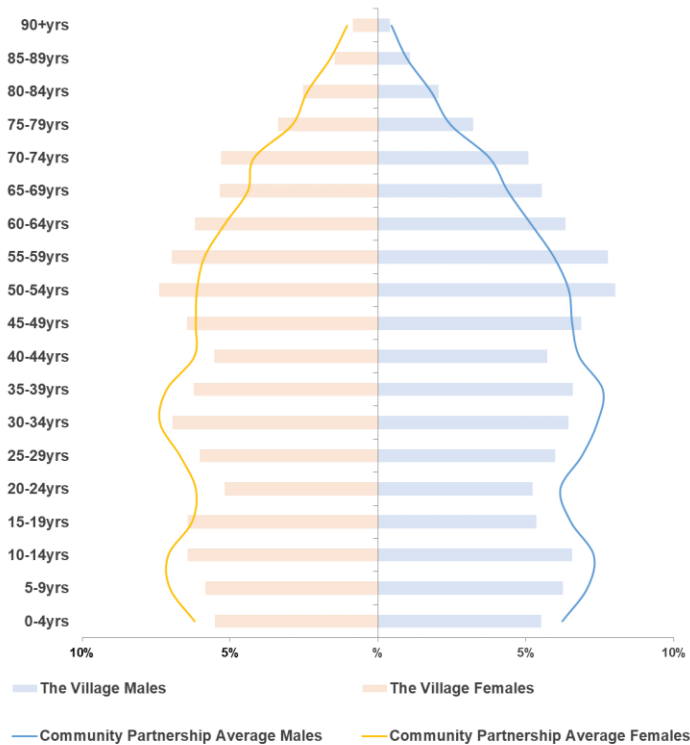
Population & Demographics

32,300 people are registered with GP practices in The Village Community Partnership which forms part of the South Locality. 79% of the population reside in Wyke, Queensbury, Thornton & Allerton and Clayton & Fairweather Green wards which are part of the Bradford South and Bradford West area committees.

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Summary

The population of The Village Community Partnership is younger than some areas of Bradford District and Craven but older than others. The health and wellbeing of the population of The Village is better than some areas but worse than others. Male and female life expectancy are above the Bradford District and Craven average and there are similar rates of premature mortality from respiratory disease, cancer and CVD compared to the average. The infant mortality rate is lower than average but there are high levels of child excess weight in reception and year 6.

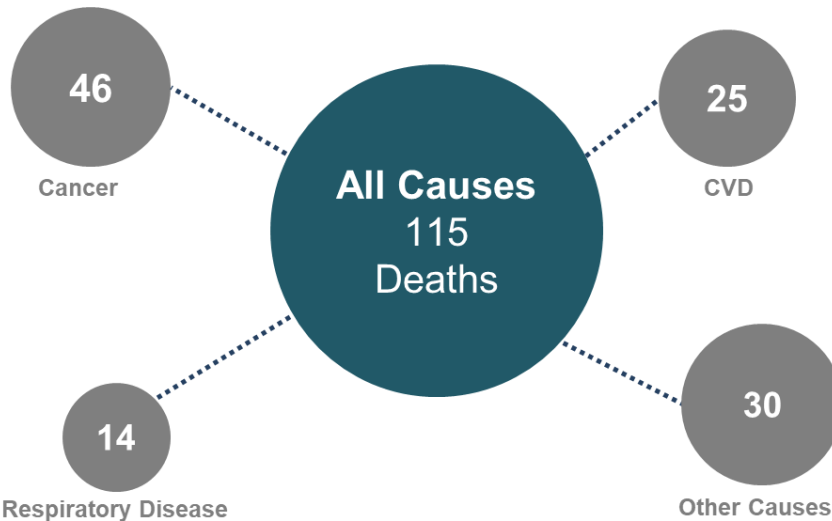

Death Rate: per 100,000 population

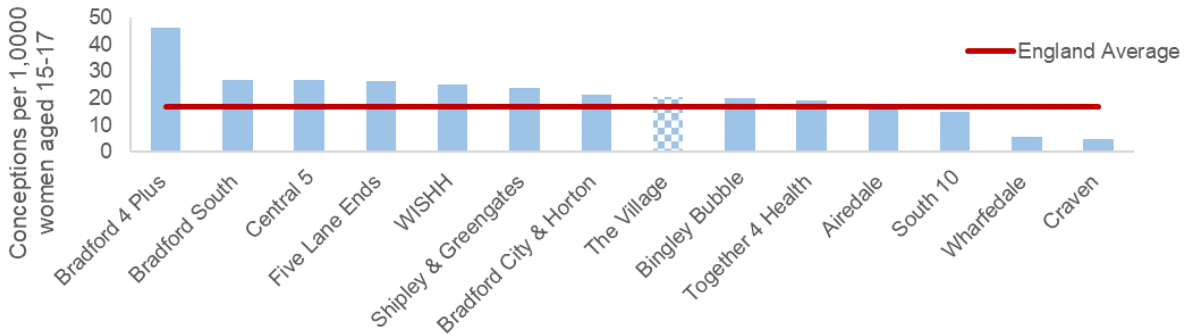

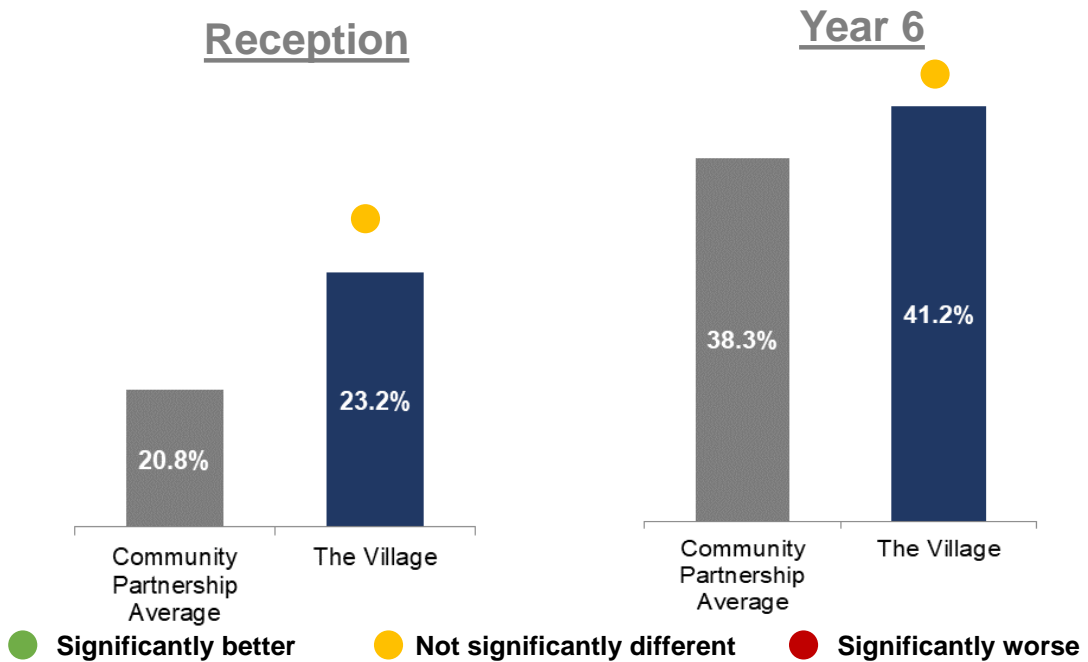
Teenage Pregnancy

2016-18



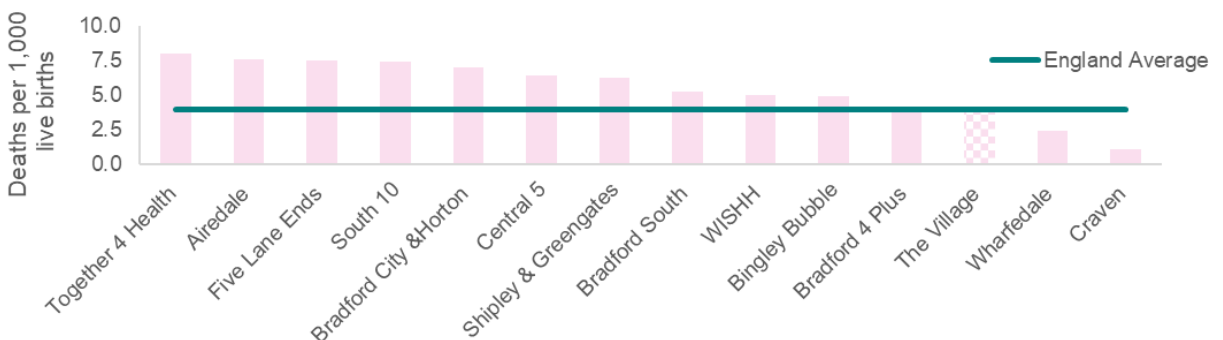
Child Excess Weight

2017/18 to 2019/20



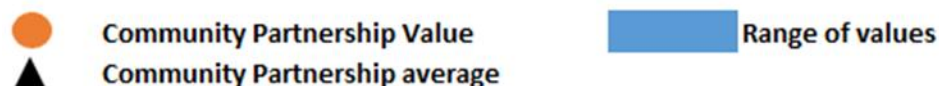
Infant Mortality
