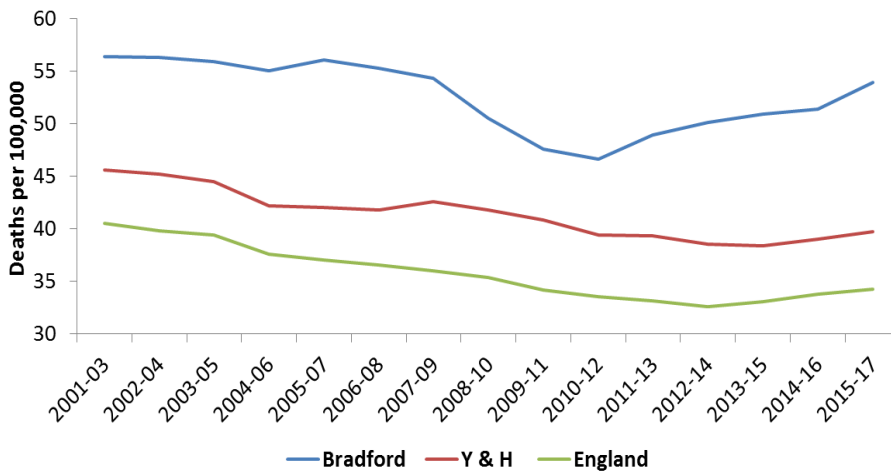

Although the under 75 mortality rate from respiratory disease in **Bradford District** has **decreased overall** since 2001, in recent years rates have begun to increase.

Bradford District continues to have a **higher** mortality rate from respiratory disease than **Yorkshire & Humber and England**.

The **gap** between England and Bradford District for this measure has **increased over time**.

Males

Mortality rates from respiratory disease for males in **Bradford District** have **decreased** since 2001.

The rate in Bradford District is **higher** than the rate for **England** on average.

The **gap** between England and Bradford District **has increased slightly** since 2001 suggesting the **national average is decreasing** at a **faster** rate.



Females

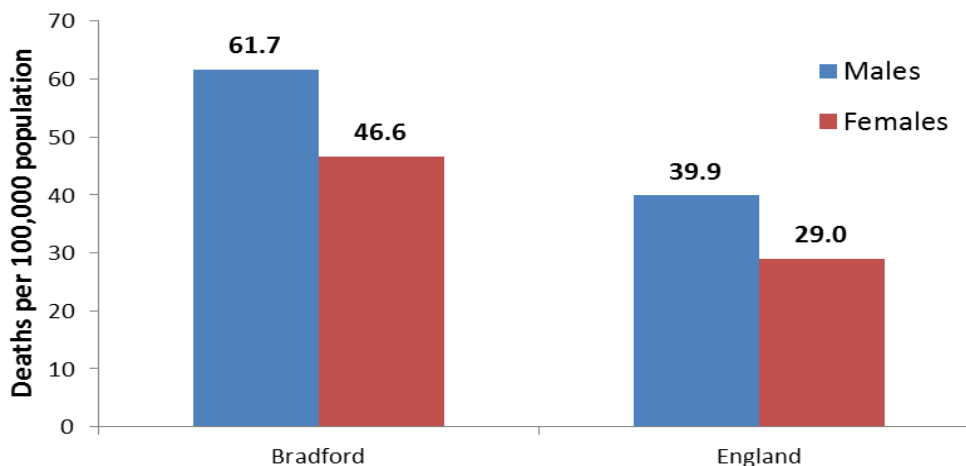
Female mortality rate from respiratory disease in **Bradford District** has **remained similar** overall since 2001.

The rate in Bradford District has remained **higher** than the **national average** since records began.

The **national average** has **decreased** over time creating a **larger gap** between Bradford District and England.



Male vs Female under 75 mortality rate from respiratory disease, 2015-17



Under 75 mortality from respiratory disease is **greater in males than females**, which follows national and regional trends.

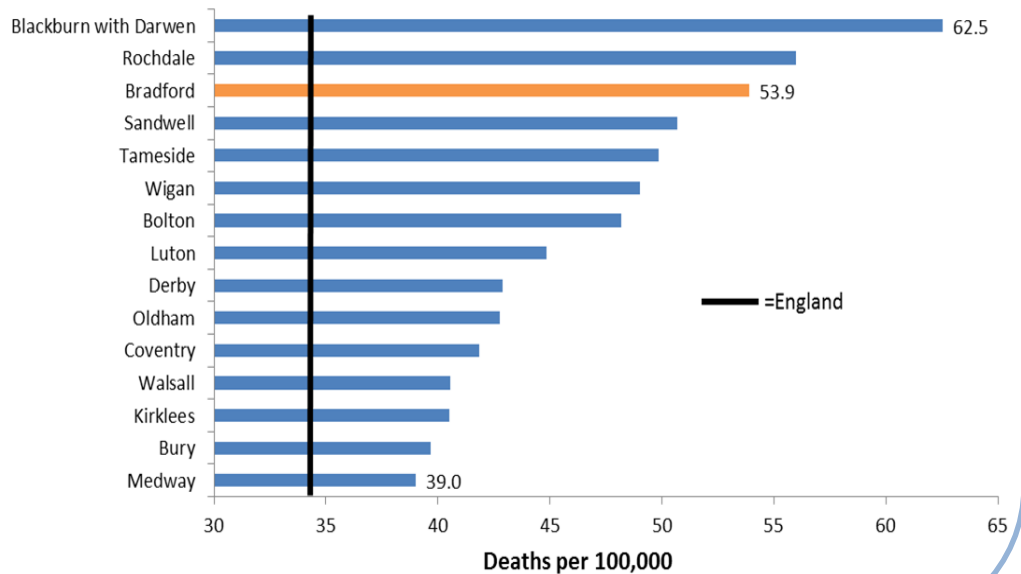
Statistical neighbours

Compared to statistically similar local authorities, **Bradford District** has the **third highest** mortality rate from respiratory disease.

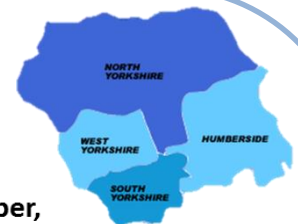
Blackburn with Darwen and **Rochdale** are the only two similar local authorities with a higher respiratory disease mortality rate.

All local authorities that are similar to Bradford District have a higher respiratory mortality rate above the **national average**.

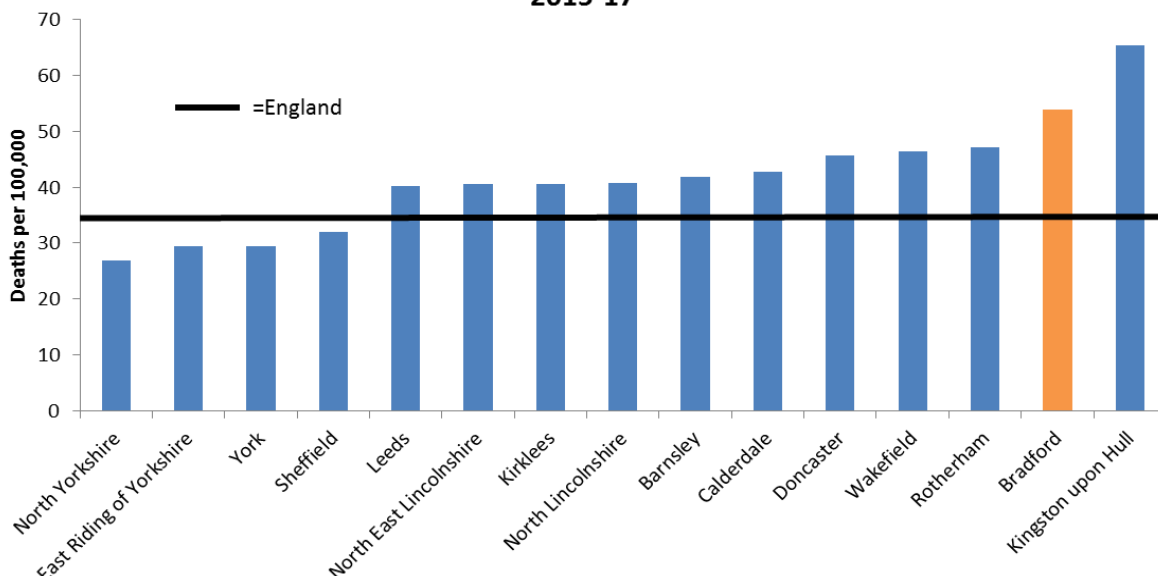
Under 75 mortality rate from respiratory disease - similar local authorities, 2015-17



Yorkshire & Humber

Compared to local authorities within Yorkshire & Humber, **Bradford District** has the **second highest** mortality rate from respiratory disease.

Kingston upon Hull has the **highest** under 75 mortality rate from respiratory disease and **North Yorkshire** has the **lowest**.
