

# The Population



Bradford is now the fifth largest local authority in England in terms of population size after Birmingham, Leeds, Sheffield, and Manchester.

In 2021 it was estimated that there were 546,400 people living in Bradford District, an increase of 4.6% (23,950 people) since the 2011 census. This is lower than the overall increase for England (6.6%).

At 4.6%, Bradford's population increase is higher than the increase for Yorkshire and The Humber (3.7%).

As of 2021, there are three people for every football pitch-sized piece of land in England. Bradford is the third most densely populated of Yorkshire and The Humber's 21 local authority areas, with around 11 people living on each football pitch-sized area of land.


**Bradford East** – 121,800 (22.3% of the District) Contains the wards Bolton & Undercliffe, Bowling & Barkerend, Bradford Moor, Eccleshill, Idle & Thackley, Little Horton

**Bradford South** – 106,400 (19.5% of the District) Contains the wards Great Horton, Queensbury, Royds, Tong, Wibsey, Wyke

**Bradford West** – 121,300 (22.2% of the District) Contains the wards City, Clayton & Fairweather Green, Heaton, Manningham, Thornton & Allerton, Toller

**Keighley** – 99,400 (18.2% of the District) Contains the wards Craven, Ilkley, Keighley Central, Keighley East, Keighley West, Worth Valley

Shipley – 97,400 (17.8% of the District) Contains the wards Baildon, Bingley, Bingley Rural, Shipley, Wharfedale, Windhill & Wrose
