Local Authorities have a number of Public Health duties that are set out in the Health and Social Care Act 2012. In order for us to carry out these duties, the Public Health department uses information from a variety of sources including - but not limited to - the Office for National Statistics (ONS), NHS Digital, Clinical Commissioning Groups (CCGs) and Hospital Trusts. This information enables the department to understand nature and causes of disease and ill health across Bradford and District.

CBMDC is bound by a number of information sharing agreements, drawn up to ensure information is received from and shared with these organisations in a way that complies with relevant legislation.

The information described above is held securely and is not disclosed to anyone unless there is a clear and specific legal purpose for doing so.
