

BD4+ Community Partnership Summary

- Areas of high deprivation in both Tong and Wyke
- Tong: high premature mortality from all causes, cancer and circulatory disease, high incidence (new cases) of all cancers and lung cancer, high all-age respiratory mortality, late antenatal booking
- Tong and Wyke: high emergency admissions with COPD
- BD4+ Community Partnership: high smoking, high COPD prevalence






