

At a glance:

- 23.5% of people in Bradford South are under-16
- 21.9% are Asian/Asian British and 19.9% are Muslim
- 30.7% of children are living in poverty and 34% of LSOAs are in the 10% most deprived in England
- Average house prices are lower than the national average
- Retail, manufacturing and transport are the biggest employers
- 76.9% of the working age population is economically active and 69.8% are in employment
- 11.6% of people aged 18-24 are unemployed
- Earnings of people living in Bradford South are lower than the national average

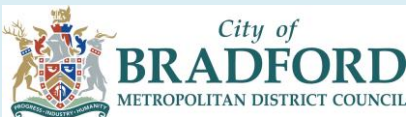
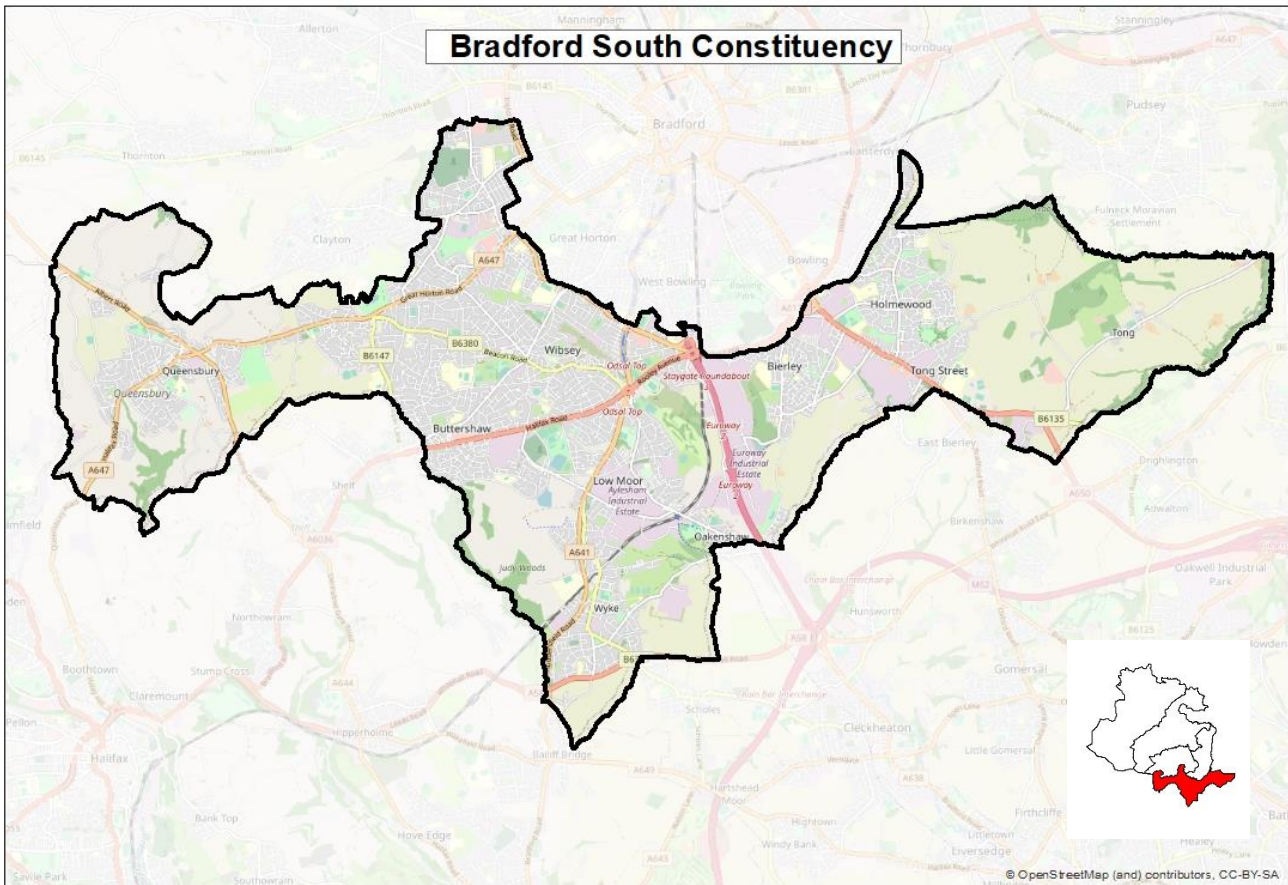
