

What does the data tell us?

- Reception aged children who are overweight (including obese) has increased to 22.4% compared to 21.2% in 2022-23.
- The prevalence of reception aged children who are overweight (including obese) in Bradford District is **above the England** average of **22.4%** and below the regional average of **23.8%**.
- Bradford District has the **74**th **highest** prevalence of reception aged children who are overweight or obese out of the 151 local authorities in England in 2023-24.
- The prevalence of year 6 children who are overweight or obese in Bradford District **decreased** to **39.0%** compared to **40.4%** in 2022-23.
- The prevalence of year 6 children who are overweight or obese in Bradford District remains **above** both national (35.8%) and regional (37.5%) averages.
- Bradford District has the **38**th **highest** year 6 children who are overweight or obese children out of the 151 local authorities in England in 2022-23.

Prevalence of overweight children in Reception




- In 2023-24, the prevalence of reception aged children who are overweight including obesity in the Bradford district increased to 22.4%.
- The prevalence of reception aged children who are overweight including obesity in the Bradford district is above the England average of 22.1% and below the regional average of 23.8%
- When compared to 151 local authorities in England, Bradford District has the 74th highest prevalence of reception aged children who are overweight or obese in England.


Prevalence of overweight children in Reception



Prevalence of overweight children in Year 6


- In 2023-24 the prevalence of Year 6 aged children who are overweight including obesity in Bradford District decreased to 39.0%.


Prevalence of overweight children in Year 6
