## Introduction



# **Affinity Community Partnership Summary**

- Areas of high deprivation in Queensbury, Shipley, Thornton & Allerton, Windhill & Wrose and Wyke
- High numbers of smokers in Windhill & Wrose, Thornton & Allerton and Wyke
- Wyke: high COPD admissions
- Queensbury and Thornton & Allerton: premature mortality from cancer high compared with England (similar to Bradford average)




