




#### Central 5 main areas

# **Central 5 Community Partnership Summary**

- High levels of deprivation in both Bradford Moor and Bowling & Barkerend
- High proportion aged under 5, late antenatal bookings, infant mortality above Bradford average
- High Year 6 obesity
- High smoking and premature mortality from all causes
- High premature mortality from circulatory disease (very high in Bradford Moor)
- Low vaccinations for people with COPD (especially COVID)
- High all-age mortality from respiratory disease and emergency admissions with COPD
- High diabetes prevalence
- Low cancer screening
- High proportion with severe mental illness diagnosis

#### **Bowling and Barkerend**

- High incidence (new cases) of lung cancer
- High premature mortality from cancer
