

# **WoW Community Partnership Summary**

- High deprivation throughout Little Horton and most of Great Horton. High deprivation in areas of Royds, Wibsey and Queensbury.
- Great Horton, Little Horton and Royds: high premature mortality (all causes)
- Great Horton and Little Horton: high premature mortality from circulatory disease, high Year 6 obesity, relatively high rates of late antenatal booking and infant mortality
- Little Horton: high rate of low birth weight
- Little Horton and Royds: high mortality from respiratory disease, high emergency admissions with COPD
- WoW Community Partnership: high smoking and COPD prevalence, low flu vaccination with COPD, low completeness for health checks in severe mental illness, low rates of cancer screening (breast, cervical)
